

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

Yildiz Technical University

AND

THE CECOS UNIVERSITY OF IT AND EMERGING SCIENCES, PESHAWAR
IN PAKISTAN

The Yildiz Technical University and CECOS University of IT and Emerging Sciences, Peshawar, Pakistan wishing to establish cooperative relationship through mutual assistance in the areas of education, research and others, and to continue the bilateral relationship between the institutions.

ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION

- 1.1 Each institution may offer to the other institutions opportunities for activities and programs, such as teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, and development that will foster and develop collaborative relationships between them.

ARTICLE 2: GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION

- 2.1 This MOU is not binding on any of the two institutions but is intended to facilitate discussions relative, but not limited, to the following general areas of cooperation. Collaboration implemented under this MOU shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and approval of the Board of Governors and the President of the CECOS University of IT and Emerging Sciences, Peshawar Pakistan in the following academic areas:
 - 2.1.1 Joint educational, cultural, and research activities.
 - 2.1.2 Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures etc.
 - 2.1.3 Exchange of advanced graduate and professional students for collaborative or independent research.
 - 2.1.4 Exchange of undergraduates and graduate students depending upon availability of funds and other resources.
 - 2.1.5 Participation in seminars and academic meetings.

2.1.6 Exchange of academic materials, publications, and other information; and

2.1.7 Special, short-term academic programs.

ARTICLE 3: DURATION

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by any of the two institutions providing sixty (60) days' advance written notice to the others.





ARTICLE 4: GENERAL MATTERS

- 4.1 **USE OF NAMES.** None of the two institutions will use the name of the other in any form of the advertising or publicity with out written permission of the other institution.
- 4.2 **AMENDMENTS.** The institutions may amend this MOU only in a writing signed by each institution's authorized signatory.
- 4.3 **NOTICES.** Any notice given under this MOU must be in writing and will be effective upon receipt evidence by:
- (a) Confirmed facsimile transmission.
 - (b) Return receipt of postage prepaid registered or certified mail; or
 - (c) Delivery confirmation by commercial overnight carrier. All communications will be sent to Liaison Officer addresses set forth below or to such other address designated by the institution concerned communicated in writing.

PREAMBLE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE PLAN

The implementation plan is proposed under the auspices of the bilateral Memorandum of Understanding which originally established general collaborative relationship between CECOS University of IT and Emerging Sciences, Peshawar Pakistan, and

Yildiz Technical University, Istanbul Turkey This document acknowledges mutual interest in the development of joint academic, administrative and research projects / programs between the two institutions.

Where financially feasible and consistent with the policies of above institutions and all others applicable legislation, the parties agree to pursue mutual interest in the following type of activities:

1. Initiation and conduct of joint relevant research projects sponsored by donor agencies.
2. Facilitate graduate students, faculty & administrative staff exchange program.
3. Short-term capacity building of CECOS University in academic, research and outreach activities.
4. Exchange of Research Scholars for short-term research and academic assignments.
5. Delivery of lectures through Video Conferencing in the fields of mutual interests.
6. Linkages for exchange of research material through internet and other means.
7. Collaboration and facilitation for the promotion of Continuing Education and Distance Education programs in the field of Engineering and allied sciences.
8. Exchange of journals, Books and Research Material.

9. Provision of laboratory equipment, audio-visual facilities and training on high-tech equipment in Engineering and allied sciences.
10. Initiation of projects for development and linkages between the institutions.
11. Any other activity conducive to achieve the desired objectives of mutual cooperation,

CLAUSES

- I. The objective of this implementation Plan is to develop the academic, research, administrative and cultural relations between CECOS University and _____ in areas of mutual interest in establishing Working Agreements/collaboration.
- II. Under the implementation Plan, cooperative work may be undertaken by sub-units of the institutions. A Working Agreement between the respective subunits may be executed and will include:
 - a. Designation of the participating institutional subunits (e.g. Departments and Programs);
 - b. Designation of one or more persons in each institution who will serve as programme leader(s) as focal person for the Working Agreement; and
 - c. General description of the kinds of cooperative work and activities to be undertaken.
- III. For each Working Agreement, the Program Leaders will be responsible for developing an annual program plan, including a description of the work and activities to be undertaken and the financial agreements to support them. The annual program plan will require approval by the chief executive officer of each institution or the officer's designated representative.
- IV. All financial arrangements relating to specific activities like travel expenses, freight charges, health insurance, and tuition, etc. will be addressed in Working Agreements
- V. Access to emergency medical care for the researches, teachers and other officials will be based on the health care programs available at the host institution.
- VI. Each institution will take steps to:
 - a. Publicize the opportunities available under this Implementation Plan and promote development of cooperation;
 - b. Assist its subunits, faculty staff and students with the administrative details of interchange; and
 - c. Establish a review process for approval and evaluation of program.
- VII. The institution, under the auspices of this Implementation Plan, may jointly sponsor conferences, short courses, regular courses, seminars and symposia, as well as exchange publications and other didactic and research materials.
- VIII. In keeping with the term of the bilateral Memorandum of Understanding, the present Implementation Plan is valid for five (5) years, and it or any clause / section may be modified or terminated by written consent of both parties who

will comply with the obligations that might be in effect on the date of termination.


- IX. Regularly employed personnel, while involved in this Implementation Plan, remain subject to the rules and regulations of their own institution in all matters of employment, benefits, medical and life insurance, employee rights, etc.
- X. This Implementation Plan does not, in and of itself, obligate CECOS University and _____ to any financial expenditure not explicit in the above. Such obligation, if will be made as part of the Working Agreements and annual program plans that may be developed under this Implementation Plan. Both parties hereby agree to comply with each and every obligation contained in this document and all those that might be in effect on the date of termination of the Implementation Plan.

Having read that present Implementation Plan, and being fully aware of the content and scope of each and every one of its clauses, the designated Liaison Officers for each institution hereby affix their signatures to the present document.
